RESOLUTION #R20-13493

Resolution relating to Declaring a Health Emergency Response to the COVID-19 Coronavirus

The City Council of the City of Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the common council with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

WHEREAS, in December, 2019 a novel strain of the coronavirus was detected, now named COVID-19, and has spread throughout numerous countries including the United States;

WHEREAS, international organizations, the federal government, state government, and local governments are all working together to contain the further spread of the disease and treat existing cases;

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization has declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern, and the United States Department of Health and Human Services has declared a Public Health Emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, the common council declares an emergency existing within the City of Superior, Douglas County, Wisconsin, under s. 323.11 Wis. stats.

The period of emergency shall be limited to the time during which the emergency conditions exist or are likely to exist in the City of Superior 60 days from adoption of the resolution.

The common council, or its designated agents, has the authority to order whatever is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare, and good order of the City of Superior during the emergency, including without limitation the power to bar, restrict, and remove all unnecessary traffic, vehicular or pedestrian, from the local highways.

Any person who violates a lawful order of the common council board or its agents made under this emergency declaration shall forfeit not more than \$100 or, in default of payment of the forfeiture, shall be subject to imprisonment for 6 months for each separate offense.

The city clerk shall publish this resolution under s. 60.80, Wis. stats., and shall become effective upon adoption by the common council and the forfeiture penalties shall become effective upon publication.
